A RESOLUTION NOMINATING DATU HALUN BADA-ASAKIL, TO THE GAWAD SA MANLIKHA NG BAYAN (GAMABA), OR THE NATIONAL LIVING TREASURES AWARD, OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE AND ARTS (NCCA).

WHEREAS, metallurgy became part of the history of mankind not only in the Philippines, but all over the world, wherein the Romans showed exceptional skills in forging war materials which were used to conquer and vanquish opposing powers during the ancient times;

WHEREAS, Philippines, before the colonization of the Spaniards were already experts in different craftsmanship, that includes woods, shells and metals and even stones were crafted into a fine jewel;

WHEREAS, Datu Halun Bada-Asakil, 65 years old, Filipino, a resident of Isabela City, and a native of tairan, Lantawan Municipality, this Province, is a traditional blacksmith utilizing traditional tools in forging iron into a useful tool and even excellent work of art;

WHEREAS, the passion in blacksmithing came into Datu Halun at a very tender age of eight (8), he was already helping his father Datu Uyong who was also a local panday of barong, pira and kalis, a bladed weapon used for day-to-day living but was also used as a mean of weapon.

WHEREAS, the years of pounding irons not only provided the family a source of livelihood but also gave Datu Halun the expertize in metallurgy, traditionally crafting irons for 57 years into a useful tool and even into an excellent works of art, which qualifies him to be considered as one of the living treasures of Isabela City.


NOW WHEREFORE, upon motion of Councilor Alan Ritchie Luis B. Biel, duly seconded by the majority of the members present, **BE IT**
