RECONSTITUTION OF ISABELA CITY EPIDEMIOLOGY AND SURVEILLANCE UNIT (CESU),

WHEREAS, Republic Act no. 11332, otherwise known as the “Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act” was enacted to protect the people from public health threats through efficient and effective disease surveillance of notifiable disease. Epidemics and health events of public health concern;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 3573, otherwise known as the “Law of Reporting of Communicable Diseases” requires all individuals and health facilities to report notifiable diseases to local and national health authorities;

WHEREAS, International Health Regulation of 2005, Article 5-1 Surveillance, urges Member State to develop, strengthen and maintain, as soon as possible but no later than five years from the entry into force of these Regulations, the capacity to detect, assess, notify and report events in accordance with these Regulations.

WHEREAS, Department of Health Administrative Order No. 2010-0017 urges all levels of the health system to strengthen the surveillance and management of AEFIs that will contribute to the credibility of the immunization program. This guideline covers provisions on investigation, legal assistance to AEFI cases and health works, risk communication, including the roles and responsibilities of concerned agencies and stakeholders;

WHEREAS, in view of the serious threat posed by the outbreak of COVID-19, Proclamation No. 922 was issued declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines due to the confirmation of the local transmission of the diseases in the country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **SITTI DJALIA T. HATAMAN**, CITY MAYOR of Isabela de Basilan, by the power vested in me by the constitution and by law, do hereby order the ***RECONSTITUTION of ISABELA CITY EPIDEMIOLOGY AND SURVEILLANCE UNIT (CESU) MEMBERS***, with the following:

SECTION 1. POLICY AND GUIDELINES. The CESU shall observe the process of disease (infectious) notification of health facilities managing COVID-19 cases and other notifiable diseases to the Epidemiology Bureau of the Department of Health and its local counterpart at all levels of local government, pursuant to the law on the Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act or R.A. 11332.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit of Isabela City shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The CESU shall have the following basic roles and responsibilities for surveillance and response:

1. Shall be responsible for conducting surveillance activities, such as but not limited to case investigation.
2. Case Investigation includes but not limited to the following:
 - a. Establishing surveillance systems in their reporting unit.
 - b. Locating and profiling of cases and review of medical records
 - c. Identifying and investigating case clusters, especially in communities and close settings
 - d. Collecting and transporting of specimens for laboratory confirmation
 - e. Encoding of surveillance, laboratory and close contact data using the available information system.
3. Consolidate data from the different Disease Reporting Units (DRU) for weekly/monthly submission to the next higher level of surveillance units.
4. Analyze and interpret data to provide disease surveillance report to the next higher level.
5. Provide technical assistance in outbreak investigations and response to their respective DRUs when necessary.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately. Done this 21st day of APRIL, 2022 at the City of Isabela de Basilan.
