EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 025

“AN ORDER CREATING THE ISABELA CITY TASK FORCE DISIPLINA (ITFD), PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION, POWERS AND FUNCTIONS, AND OTHER PURPOSES”

WHEREAS, Section 16, Article X of the 1987 Philippine Constitution promotes the right of the people and their organizations to effective and reasonable participation at all levels of social, political, and economic decision-making;

WHEREAS, Section 34, Chapter IV of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that LGUs shall promote the establishment and operation of people's non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the current administration of the City Government of Isabela adopts inclusive governance as a policy to realize democratic principles and values where people's participation is truly manifested and practiced;

WHEREAS, there is a need to increase the active participation of each and every resident of Isabela City in the implementation of laws, ordinances, rules and regulations by inculcating in them the sense of ownership and belongingness where personal responsibility is the norm;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), through Memorandum Circular No. 2019-181 dated October 24, 2019, providing details and guidelines for the government-wide national advocacy campaign for a culture of discipline dubbed as "Disiplina Muna";

WHEREAS, there is a need to align, coordinate, maximize, and expand the efforts of the City Government of Isabela to promote a culture of discipline in adhering to the rule of law;

WHEREAS, there is a need to intensify the implementation of various ordinances, laws, rules and regulations in the City of Isabela to promote the general welfare and faith of the people to the government;

1. To ensure the effective, efficient and coordinated implementation of pertinent laws and city ordinances such as but not limited to the following:
 - a. Traffic Management – including but not limited to, the Isabela City Traffic Ordinance;
 - b. Road Clearing – including but not limited to, Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 dated July 29, 2019, and all other regulations issued by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and the Land Transportation Office (LTO);
 - c. Prohibition on Sidewalk Vending – including, but not limited to, the Isabela City Market Code and the Isabela City Traffic Ordinance;
 - d. Anti-Littering – including but not limited to, the Anti-Littering Ordinance of Isabela City;
 - e. Anti-Smoking – including but not limited to, Executive Order No. 26 issued by President Rodrigo Duterte; and Executive Order No. 054 s. 2017;
 - f. Disaster Preparedness and Resilience – including but not limited to, the DILG Operation Listo;
 - g. Revenue Code of Isabela City
 - h. Building Code of the Philippines
 - i. Ecological Solid Waste Management Act
 - j. Anti-Rabies Act
 - k. Meat Inspection Code, as amended
 - l. Other policies, laws, ordinances, rules and regulations aimed at promoting public order, safety, cleanliness, and the general welfare of the people of Isabela.
2. Formulate plans and policies that will ensure public safety, cleanliness, peace and order in all public areas, spaces, economic enterprises, roads and thoroughfares within the jurisdiction of the City of Isabela;

3. Undertake operations, monitoring and apprehension activities in line with the abovementioned duties;
4. Facilitate coordination among key offices, agencies, establishments and organizations for the implementation and compliance of relevant laws, ordinances, policies, rules and regulations;
5. Recommend the formulation, enactment, revision, amendment of ordinances if necessary.
6. Regularly report to the Local Chief Executive on matters pertaining to the implementation of this order.
7. Perform other tasks and functions that may be assigned by the Local Chief Executive from time to time.

III. REPEALING CLAUSE

All Executive Orders, rules, and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby revoked, amended, or modified accordingly.

IV. EFFECTIVITY

This order shall take effect immediately.
