



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 033

“AN ORDER PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES FOR *UNDAS* 2022 IN THE CITY OF ISABELA, BASILAN”

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 1987 Constitution and Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Government of Isabela shall be primarily responsible for the promotion of the general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2020, the President of the Philippines issued Proclamation No. 922 declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines in order to prompt a whole-of-government approach in addressing the COVID-19 outbreak;

WHEREAS, the threat of COVID-19 is still lingering in our communities Three (3) years since the initial outbreak;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to implement guidelines for observance of *Undas* 2022 (All Saints Day and All Souls Day) in the whole City of Isabela so as to maintain order, cleanliness, and to prevent the spread and transmission of COVID-19;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SITTI DJALIA A. TURABIN-HATAMAN, City Mayor of Isabela, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order as follows:

I. *UNDAS* 2022 GUIDELINES

- a. All private and public cemeteries and memorial parks, including columbaria and the like shall remain opened during the period of *Undas*.
- b. The public may visit cemeteries, memorial parks, and columbaria subject to observance of minimum public standards. The venue must only allow maximum of 90% and 70% capacity for outdoor and indoor respectively.
- c. Common entrance and exit gates shall be subject for control and monitoring with separate ingress and egress;
- d. Visitors must strictly abide by minimum public health standards to prevent COVID-19 transmission. Wearing of face masks and observance of social distancing are mandatory;

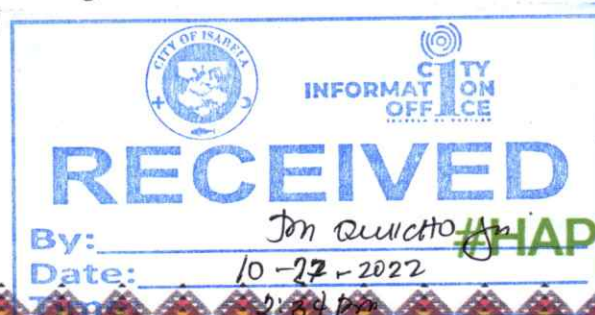

- e. The Isabela City PNP, BHERT, CDRRMO, CHO, and other concerned authorities are tasked to implement this order and shall assign their respective personnel in all private and public cemeteries and memorial parks to ensure compliance and maintain peace and order, as well as assist the public.
- f. The PNP – City Traffic Management Division shall be responsible for the management of vehicle traffic;
- g. No drinking of liquor or any alcoholic beverages;
- h. Gambling activities in any form will not be allowed;
- i. Only flowers, candles and cleaning tools are allowed to be brought inside;
- j. Loud noises/music/instruments are not allowed inside the cemetery premises;
- k. Firearms or bladed weapons and other similar items are prohibited except those that may fall under Letter (i) above; and
- l. Other measures may be implemented from time to time as may be necessary.

II. SEPARATION CLAUSE AND SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDELINES

1. Should any of the provisions of this Order runs contrary to the Guidelines issued or to be issued by the Provincial Government of Basilan, National IATF, DILG, DOH, DOTR, DTI, CSC and other competent authorities, the latter guidelines shall prevail and are hereby adopted as supplementary to this order, unless specifically declared otherwise.

III. EFFECTIVITY

2. This order shall take effect immediately.
