



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 042

**RECONSTITUTING THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB)
OF THE CITY OF ISABELA, PROVINCE OF BASILAN**

WHEREAS, Rule XIII, Article 63 (f) (Local Special Bodies), of the 1991 Local Government Code and Chapter III, C, Section 43 of Republic Act No. 6975 otherwise known as the "Department of the Interior and Local Government Act of 1990" and supplemented by DILG Memorandum Circular Nos. 988-174 dated September 21, 1998 provides for the creation of the People's Law Enforcement Boards (PLEBs) in every city/municipality purposely to conduct hearing and adjudication of citizen's complaints against uniformed members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) for offenses committed in their area of jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, on March 6, 1998 Republic Act No. 8551 otherwise known as the "PNP Reform and Reorganization Act of 1998" took effect and amending among others, Section 43 of R.A. 6975, in order to further strengthen the PLEB;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SITTI DJALIA T. HATAMAN, City Mayor of Isabela City, Province of Basilan, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby **ORDER**:

Section 1. Reconstitution of the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB).

As provided under Section 43 of the RA 6975 as amended by RA 8551 and other related issuance, the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) of Isabela City is hereby reconstituted to be composed of the following:

Section 2. Selection of PLEB Chairman, Secretariat and Office.

Under the auspices of the CLGOO, DILG Isabela City Field Operations Office, immediately after the approval of this Executive Order, the aforementioned PLEB members shall officially convene and elect among themselves the Chairmanship position of the PLEB of Isabela City. Thereafter, they shall officially take their oath of office and perform their duties and functions as required of their positions.

Upon concurrence of the majority of the PLEB members, the Board shall select their secretariat and, in coordination with the Office of the City Mayor, identify its office and session hall.

Section 3. PLEB Duties and Functions.

The PLEB through its respective members shall have the power, and are primarily tasked to conduct hearings and adjudication of all citizen complaints formally filed with, referred to it, against uniformed members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) for offense committed, and if warranted, impose the corresponding penalty as prescribed under existing laws, PLEB guidelines and PLEB rules and regulations.

Section 4. Funding Support.

Fund allocation for the operations and maintenance of the PLEB including payment of corresponding honorarium, life insurance and other entitlements of its members and other incidental expenses shall be incorporated in the Annual Budget of the City of Isabela.

Section 6. Repealing Clause.

All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 7. Effectivity Clause.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
