A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE COLLECTIVE SENSE OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF ISABELA ON THE MATTER OF GRANTING THE SERVICE RECOGNITION INCENTIVE (SRI) TO THE CITY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES OF ISABELA CITY FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2020 AS CONTAINED IN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 37 ISSUED BY HIS EXCELLENCY, PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE DATED DECEMBER 18, 2020.

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Administrative Order No. 37 dated December 18, 2020 which authorizes the grant of a one-time Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) at a uniform rate not exceeding Ten Thousand Pesos (10,000.00) to government employees;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of AO 37, paragraphs a. and b. provide as follows:

"a. The grant of the one-time SRI to employees in LGUs, including those in the barangays, shall be determined by their respective *Sanggunians* depending on the LGU's financial capability, subject to the PS limitation in LGU budgets under RA No. 7260 of the "Local Government Code of 1991", and the conditions set in Section 2 hereof, at a uniform rate not exceeding Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00), chargeable against their respective FY 2020 Local Government Funds.

Should the identified funding source prove insufficient to cover the full amount of the SRI, lower but uniform amount shall be paid to all qualified employees of the LGU; and

“b. In determining the amount of the SRI, the sanggunians shall exercise prudence and judicious use of government funds, ensuring that the expenditure is reasonable and will not, in any way, adversely affect the delivery of service to the public”;

WHEREAS, the employees of the City Government of Isabela, whether occupying regular, contractual or casual positions, deserve an incentive considering of a possibility that an unexpended funds exist from savings of Personnel Services (PS) which could comply the mandate of the said Administrative Order even at a lower but uniform amount;

WHEREAS, the granting of the Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) may be interpreted as mandatory in nature considering that *“should identified funding source prove insufficient to cover the full amount of the SRI, lower but uniform amount shall be paid to all qualified employees of the LGU”*;

After due deliberation on the matter, on motion of Councilor Candu I. Muarip, duly seconded by all members present, **BE IT**

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Isabela, Province of Basilan, express the collective sense of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Isabela on the matter of granting the Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) to the City Government Employees of Isabela City for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020, as contained in Administrative Order No. 37 issued by his excellency, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte dated December 18, 2020.
