AN ORDER CREATING THE ISABELA CITY YOUTH DEVELOPMENT ALLIANCE (ICYDA)

WHEREAS, the City of Isabela that was identified as a project site for Opportunity 2.0 financed by the United States Agency for International Development or USAID.

WHEREAS, Opportunity 2.0 will be working with Isabela City LGUs and partner institution and civil society to address the significant challenges facing out-of-school youth (OSY) through the establishment of Isabela City Youth Development Alliance (ICYDA).


WHEREAS, the ICYDA shall serve as a local body to institutionalize the participation of all sectors in addressing OSY issues and concerns and in identifying the appropriate program interventions for OSYs through planning, direction-setting and mobilizing resources to support OSY program and services.

WHEREAS, the Isabela City YDA's vision is to become a dynamic alliance that empowers Out of School Youth as agent of change, peace and development in Isabela City through its mission of collaborating and networking with stakeholders and share resources in advancing the welfare of OSY's in order to develop them into productive, skilled and civically engaged members of the community.

WHEREAS, the OSY development plan shall be the central hallmark of the OSYDA which shall serve as a multiple-stakeholder engagement mechanism where stakeholders are supported to take the lead in identifying their own priorities, developing resource strategies and crafting actionable plans that are responsive to local OSY needs, opportunities and assets.

NOW THEREFORE, I, SITTI DJALIA A. TURABIN-HATAMAN, City Mayor of Isabela City, Basilan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order as follows:

Article I

Section 1. Creation of ICYDA. There is hereby created as Isabela City Youth Development Alliance to be composed of the following with the respective duties and functions.

1.0 Office of the City Mayor Thru ICYDA shall:

- a.) Act the chairperson of the ICYDA
- b.) Lead in the formulation of an annual OSY development plans
- c.) Mobilize resources from among the member-agencies to support OSY programs, services and initiatives to allocate on a yearly-basis in their respective annual investment program.

2.0 City Social Welfare and Development shall:

- a.) Provide counselling sessions for OSY's to become self-reliant, economically productive and socially responsible citizens.
- b.) Assist in the identification and profiling of OSY's in the communities as well as in determining the proper interventions to address their needs and concerns as basis for OSY programming.
- c.) Provide psycho-social services to OSY's

3.0 City Agriculture Office shall:

- a.) Provide technical know-how and available farm inputs on agricultural production and technology for OSY agri-based projects.
- b.) Assist in the identification of market niche on fisheries, livestock, rice and corn production, vegetable production and HV crops as basis for OSY training program offerings.
- c.) Provide information on suitable areas for farming.

4.0 City Population Office shall:

- a.) Provide learning sessions on responsible parenthood for parents of OSY's and for young parents as well.
- b.) Conduct advocacy campaign on adolescent health and youth development in project sites.

5.0 City Planning and Development Office shall:

- a.) Assist OSY in the formulation of plan/community service projects.
- b.) Provide available logistics to support OSY community projects.

6.0 City Information Office shall:

- a.) Lead in the advocacy campaign and awareness building in the development of OSY's in local government units and communities.
- b.) Provide documentation and sharing of ICYDA and OSY success.

7.0 City Local Madrasah Development Office shall:

- a.) Provide spiritual counselling to OSY's
- b.) Advocate RH in Islamic perspective and environment.

8.0 The PESO shall:

- a.) Provide Job Counselling and employment coaching for OSY job seekers.
- b.) Provide job referrals to local overseas employment through National Skills Registry System.
- c.) Share labor market information as basis for OSY development planning.
- d.) Organize and conduct job fairs.

9.0 SP Chairman on Education shall:

- a.) Enact OSY friendly ordinances to promote OSY's welfare and development
- b.) Initiate local legislative action to support and institutionalize OSY program in the City's Annual Investment Plan.

10.0 DepEd-ALS shall provide technical assistance in the conduct of the following:

- a.) Recruitment, screening, placement and certification of potential ALS Learners.
- b.) Training of Instructional Managers, and Learning Facilitators.
- c.) Profiling of learners and communities.
- d.) Sharing of learning resource materials for ALS program.
- e.) Collaboration with other stakeholders for the skill training program.
- f.) Facilitating learning group sessions, program monitoring and evaluation.

11.0 Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) shall:

- a.) Provide managerial and entrepreneurial thru trainings, seminars (Business consultancy) as a post-training interventions for OSY completers.
- b.) Provide marketing assistance; product development/clinics to OSY-led business enterprise and livelihood ventures.

12.0 Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) shall:

- a.) Provide livelihood opportunities and wage employment for OSY training program completers.
- b.) Facilitate the registration of OSY organization.
- c.) Participate in the alliance monitoring and relevant services/interventions.
- d.) Share administrative and operational resources.
- e.) Referral to wage employment.
- f.) Facilitate job-matching of OSY program completers with the business sectors.
- g.) Provide labor/job marker information as basis for OSY program interventions.

13.0 National Commission on Indigenous People shall:

- a.) Promote awareness on IP's youth regarding the program.
- b.) Preservation and Promotion of Indigenous Knowledge System and Practices- IKSP
- c.) Education on IPRA Law
- d.) Provide education/financial assistance to IP-OSY's.

14.0 Technical Education Skills and Development Authority (TESDA) shall:

- a.) Provide available Trainers and assist in identification of Trainers for Skills training program in the project site.
- b.) Facilitate and conduct skills assessment and certification of OSY program completers.
- c.) Provide training program scholarship (skills upgrading) for OSY completers.

15.0 Philippine Information Agency (PIA) shall:

- a.) Conduct sharing sessions for OSY's on personality development and communication skills.
- b.) Assist in the development of OSY's leadership skills and in raising social consciousness and responsibility.
- c.) Lead in the advocacy campaign and awareness building in the development of OSY's in local government units and communities.
- d.) Provide documentation and sharing of ICYDA and OSY success.

16.0 Nagdilaab Foundation Incorporated (NFI) shall:

- a.) Acts as an Overseer of OSY programs and services implemented in the communities.
- b.) Monitor, evaluate and assess all OSY programs developed and initiated by the ICYDA.
- c.) Reports to the ICYDA on a regular basis on accomplishment, progress updates on OSY programs to include issues and concerns related to program implementation.

17.0 Isabela Foundation Incorporated (IFI) shall:

- a.) Provide Membering sessions on life skills and other capacity building services for OSY's
- b.) Share its resources, expertise and available equipment for the use of OSY's productive activities in communities.

18.0 Chamber of Commerce and Industry shall:


- a.) Provide linkages for trained/skilled OSY's to job opportunities in local industries and businesses.
- b.) Extend marketing assistance to OSY, engaged in entrepreneurial activities as well as link them to financial assistance as may be possible.
- c.) Provide small business capacity building to OSY-led enterprises.


19.0 OSY Representatives shall:

- a.) Provide ICYDA with planning inputs such as OSY situations, needs and concerns and barangay-level OSY development plans derived from annual OSY consultations.
- b.) Lead in the dissemination of ICYDA's program direction plans and activities progress updates to the youth populace in the communities.
- c.) Articulate proposed OSY-led programs and activities for possible funding by ICYDA member-agencies.

This is at will and shall remain in effect until modified or terminated by the partners' consent.
